Philosophy of Word of God Curriculum

As a family of believers, we are committed to grow in our faith, reach out to others, worship, and serve the Triune God. It is our goal to proclaim, teach, and apply faithfully the Word of God in all courses of instruction in keeping with the Holy Scriptures. The Word of God is taught to bring our students into a closer relationship with their Savior. It provides the means whereby the child is assured of their eternal salvation and motivates the child to live a Christian life while here on earth.

Whether through the daily Word of God classes, classroom devotions, Catechism lessons, hymnology classes, or memory work, Law and Gospel based on God's Word will be presented. The Law shows us our sinful nature while the Gospel shows us our loving Savior and the work he has done for us.

Premises for Word of God Curriculum

We teach Word of God based on a number of premises that guide and control the entire curriculum. These premises are revealed to us by God in his Word. We accept them as essential to Christian nurture only because God the Holy Spirit has led us to this conviction by working faith in our hearts.

These premises are as follows:

1. God's Word is truth.
 - God's Word is verbally inspired, inerrant, and infallible.
2. God's Word is christocentric.
 - The chief purpose of the Bible is to reveal God's saving plan, which enters in Christ.
3. The two main teachings of God's Word are law and gospel.
 - The law teaches us God's holy will, that is, what He requires all people to do and not to do. Because all are sinful by nature and sin daily, the law also teaches us that we are all sinners who deserve God's punishment of death and eternal damnation.
 - The gospel teaches us the good news of God's grace and mercy. It proclaims that God in love sent Jesus to take away the sins of all people and that everyone who believes in Jesus has eternal life and salvation
4. God's Word is
 - the means by which God brought us to faith
 - the continuing motivation for living a life of faith-born love to God's glory
 - the means God has given us to bring unbelievers to saving faith

- the means by which we continually nurture one another to grow in saving faith and to live a sanctified life

Objectives for Word of God Curriculum

These premises make it evident that a curriculum which is designed to carry out God-pleasing Christian nurture will be based on God's Word and will aim at carrying out the purpose for which God gave us his Word.

The general objectives of Christian nurture, therefore, are:

1. that by learning the law, Christians realize ever more fully their sinfulness and utter helplessness to save themselves
2. that by learning the gospel, Christians grow in their knowledge of God the Father as their loving Creator, God the Son and their gracious Redeemer, and God the Holy Spirit as their enlightening Sanctifier
3. that by learning the gospel, Christians keep growing in faith, ever more firmly embracing Christ as their only hope of salvation and accepting with childlike trust everything in the Bible as God's inspired and inerrant truth
4. that by learning the gospel as motivation and the law as a guide, Christians continue to grow in living lives of thanksgiving to God for his undeserved grace
5. that by being trained in the proper use of law and gospel, Christians are enabled to use the gifts God has given them to share the saving faith with others and to nurture fellow Christians in this faith
6. that by continual personal and group Bible study, Christians grow daily in faith and in leading in a Christian life

Attitudes We Pray Students Want to Develop in Word of God

- Desiring a faith that trust completely in Jesus.
- Appreciating Jesus' love and forgiveness.
- Trusting that Jesus is always with us, watching over us, and providing for all of our needs.
- Desiring to reach out to others and share the wonderful message of Jesus Christ.
- Being grateful for the most wonderful gift ever received: salvation through Jesus Christ.
- Desiring to show love for others.
- Being willing to forgive others when they sin.
- Valuing spiritual gifts above all else.
- Being thankful for all of God's blessings.
- Desiring to hear and study God's Word because there is nothing more important.
- Being eager to listen, study, and grow in God's Word.
- Feeling sorry for sins committed and trusting in God's forgiveness.
- Valuing the Word of God, rather than earthly riches, as his or her greatest treasure.
- Trusting that Jesus has power over death, so there is no need to fear it or any trouble.
- Wanting to honor Jesus for being our Savior.
- Desiring to show love for God by serving Him.
- Desiring to mold all attitudes based on Christ's forgiveness and what he tells us in His Word.
