### **Teacher Call Window**

The window for calling active teachers from the field begins on **October 15, 2024** and runs through **April 15, 2025**.

- Teacher call list requests are submitted electronically at wels.net/callrequest.
- Request forms must be complete and submitted at least 14 days prior to the requested call meeting. Calling bodies should use the two weeks to prepare all items for the call packet electronically, so that the call and accompanying documents may be e-mailed to the candidate called within 12 hours of the meeting.
- Remember to include compensation information using the compensation calculator: cwcompcalc.wels.net.

### **NWEA Testing Update**

CLS is finalizing a contract with NWEA to assist schools who do not meet the newly imposed 120 student MAP Growth license minimum. Our office will prepay NWEA for these smaller schools and then bill them accordingly. If your school has been using MAP but are discontinuing use for 2024-2025 please advise lutheranschools@wels.net immediately so we do not pay licensing for your school. Schools with MAP Growth enrollment of 120 students or more will be invoiced directly by NWEA.

#### Kids c.a.r.e.

The kids c.a.r.e. (care about reaching everyone with the gospel) program is designed to teach children about



mission outreach. The Lutheran Women's Missionary Society's kids c.a.r.e. project for 2024-25 is Antigua: St. John's Church and School!

St. John's Lutheran School opened in 1974 and currently serves children in preschool through Grade 6. Your gifts will provide general support to St. John's Lutheran Church and School as they reach out with the gospel message to the children and families they serve.

Free materials are available at **lwms.org/kidscare** including: instruction letter, poster, offering box template, parent trifold brochure, and a poster coloring sheet. There are three levels of lesson plans: PreK-Grade 1 (non-readers), lower-level (Grades 2-5) and upper-level (Grades 6-8). Each level has two lesson plans, designed to be integrated with the Christ Light curriculum, and will contain age-appropriate enrichment activities, such as music, crafts, recipes, and activity sheets.
