Divine Call Updates

The volume of teacher calls continues to be exceedingly high with a total teacher vacancy count nearing 200. We are happy to report that over 30% of teacher calls extended have been accepted this calling season. Of the 104 calls accepted to this point, 19 are from WELS members who have education degrees and have been called provisionally as they are not ministry certified, and nine of the calls were accepted by ministry trained workers who were available but have not served in over a year. If you know of a WELS member who would like to be considered for a provisional call, please contact your district president to begin the process.

Leadership Credential Cohorts

The Principal Credential Cohort program and EC Director Cohort program invite individuals who have demonstrated three or more years of successful teaching experience, recognized leadership gifts and characteristics, and are not currently serving in, or are new to a leadership role to participate. The cohorts provide support from mentors and fellow participants, three leadership training events, and a 50% scholarship for graduate coursework through MLC. MSOE School Business Certificate for School Leaders

This 15-credit certificate offers four core courses to educators looking to learn more about business acumen in a school setting. Courses are offered synchronously online. The duration of the certificate program is one year, with students taking one class at a time. A grant from the Kern foundation is available to significantly reduce participant's costs.
